Anna Majcherczyk

Violinist

Born in Kraków, Poland, violinist Anna Majcherczyk graduated with honors from the Music Academy in Kraków and the University of Music and Performing Arts in Graz, and continued her studies at the Universität Mozarteum in Salzburg as a recipient of the Socrates-Erasmus Scholarship. As concertmaster of the Kraków Youth Philharmonic Orchestra, she made her solo debut at the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam. As a member of different ensembles she has since performed in major venues including the Musikvereinsaal in Vienna, the Berliner Philharmonie, and Carnegie Hall.

From 2012 to 2018, she served as Associate Leader of the Second Violins with the Bremen Philharmonic Orchestra.

Now based in New York, Anna is active as both an orchestral leader and chamber musician. She appears regularly as concertmaster with the New York Repertory Orchestra and the Brooklyn Chamber Orchestra and is deeply engaged in chamber music collaborations. Particularly drawn to diverse and exploratory programming, she enjoys performing in flexible ensemble settings. She is a member of the Majcherczyk & Casal Duo (violin and viola), with whom she recently recorded a program released by the American Viola Society.

Arianna Kalian

Oboist

Originally from NYC, Arianna Kalian, oboe, is an avid chamber musician, performing with varied combinations of instruments including strings, harp and organ. She is also oboist with the New York City-based orchestra Higher Word. She currently serves on the Board of Directors of Basically Beethoven, a chamber music organization based in Dallas.

Arianna was previously a member of the L'Amore della Musica woodwind quintet and the Chatham Chamber Ensemble reed trio in NYC, both ensembles of which were noted for their community outreach.

During her prior residence in Michigan, she served as Principal Oboe with the Southern Great Lakes Symphony, and performed in numerous chamber orchestras in the Detroit metropolitan area focused on the choral repertoire of J.S. Bach.

Ms. Kalian also appeared as solo recitalist at the Villa Clementine in Wiesbaden, Germany and at the Merton College Chapel at Oxford University, England.
